Sonia has been a tremendous asset in our community for many years as well as a beloved member of our congregation. Additionally, while she has touched many lives locally, she has also advocated globally for those victims of genocide and hatred worldwide in Darfur and elsewhere.

As a fellow congregant, she has attended high holiday services annually at Temple Ner Tamid where she has mesmerized us with her emotional poetry readings and Holocaust remembrance services. She has been recognized nationally by being appointed to the United States Holocaust Memorial Council, and she currently serves as the education director for the Holocaust Center Boston North. Sonia has also received the State of Israel Award, been recognized by the U.S. Congress, and been named “woman of the year” by B’nai B’rith.
